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

had not studied music or piano before. Instruments played were 2 pianos, a violin, 2 vibraharps, 2 harps, 2 keyboards and organ. The program consisted of thirty-one pieces. Each student played a memorized solo and at least one duet. One person played four duets. This year we enjoyed hearing three duets played on two pianos: "Jesu, Joy of Man's Desiring" by J.S. Bach; "Canon in D" by J. Pachelbel and "Sonate I" by Clementi.



All the students participated in the final piece, an ensemble, "Ah! Vous Dirai-Je, Maman". Mozart wrote twelve variations for this music. The melody dates back to the 18th Century and has been called by different names, such as "Twinkle, Twinkle Little Star" and "The Alphabet Song". Our orchestra included a piano, a violin, 2 vibraharps, 2 harps, 2 keyboards (flute and clarinet sounds), organ as well as a "Glass Armonica" sextet, which is a glorified name for six glasses filled with different levels of water to create different tones. The sound was created by wetting the finger and rubbing it on the rim of the glass. A wonderful memory which I have of the entire recital is seeing each child with a smile on their face as they stepped up to play. We thank the "Beloved Mighty I AM Presence" and the Ascended Host for all Their Assistance and Miracles which made this recital a wonderful success! ~ Miss Doreen
