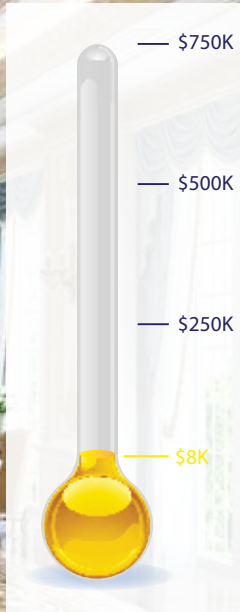


CAMPUS UPDATE:

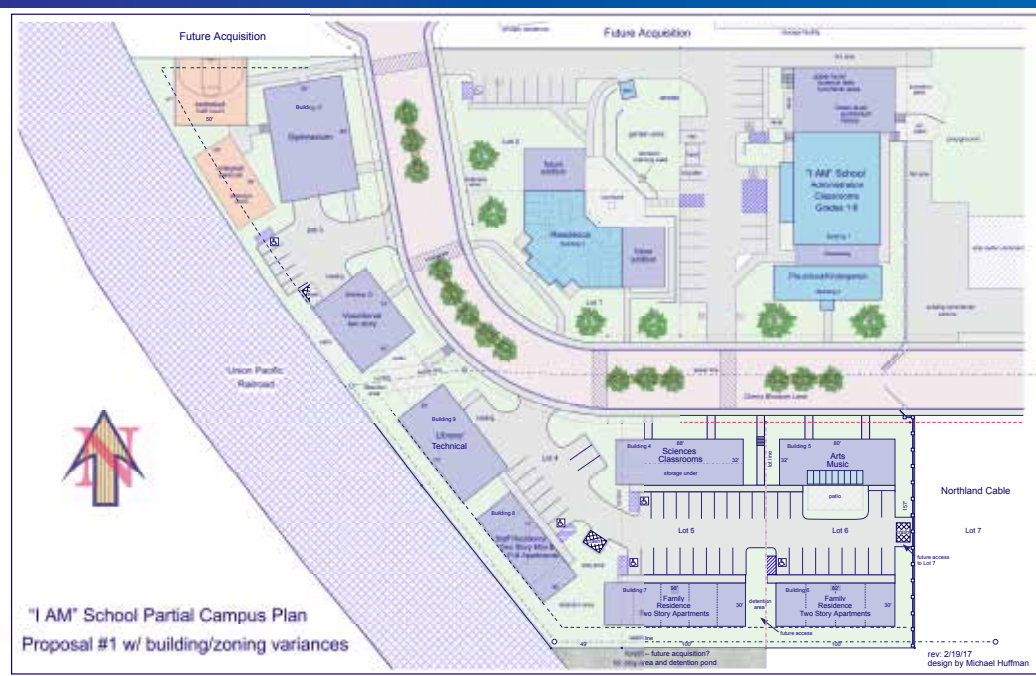

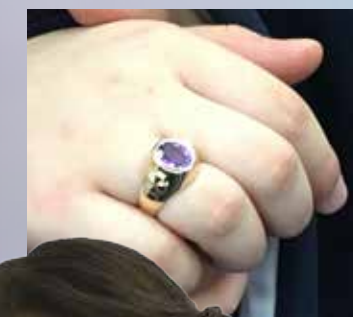
